Main tasks/ responsibilities	<p>Our main tasks include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • acting in the best interests of Women Golf Members with the goal of ensuring all Women Golf Members have the opportunity to enjoy their golf and golf related activities at BGC. • managing matters relating to women only golf competitions and events.. • reporting Women's Golf results • setting up and finalising golf software for women's golf events. • prepare a monthly report for the Club Captain on achievements, future events and recommendations. • developing initiatives to increase field sizes of women's competitions • Inducting new members • adjudicating on rulings and match disputes. • selecting players for Women's representative teams. • refereeing where playing conditions stipulate a referee is required. • recommending local rules, course markings and conditions of play to the Club Captain • In the absence of the Women's Captain, Women's Golf Committee representative and Club Captain, the Club Professional shall determine match decisions. This includes adjudicating on all matters pertaining to play on the course where an urgent decision is required. 				
Committee Composition	<p>The Women's Golf Committee is comprised of:</p> <p>Captain: To oversee all issues related to Bathurst Women's Golf; liaise and report to the Manager and Club Captain of Bathurst Golf Club; represent the Committee on the Club's Match Committee</p> <p>Vice-Captain: To assist the Captain with their responsibilities.</p> <p>Match Committee members: to organise and coordinate all competitions and golf related issues.</p> <p>Expressions of Interest will be called for each September prior to the Women's Forum</p>
